O R D E R

On July 30, 1992, the Commission received an application from the Webster County Water District ("Webster County") wherein it proposes to construct major additions and improvements to its water distribution system; adjust water service rates and charges; and issue certain securities. In its filing, Webster County requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 6(9) and 10(2)(d).


807 KAR 5:001, Section 6(9), requires that a detailed income statement and balance sheet covering operations for a 12 month period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date the application is filed to be attached to the application. Section 10(2)(d), requires that monthly revenues and operating expenses for the test year be attached to the application. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the


Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to adequately review Webster County's filing. Therefore, its request for a deviation from the above-cited regulations should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Webster County's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 6(9) and 10(2)(d), is hereby granted.
