O R D E R

On April 12, 1993, AmeriCall, Inc., an ATC Company, filed a letter with the Commission requesting clarification concerning the service list in this proceeding.

In view of the voluminous service list the Commission finds that it would be unduly burdensome to require each Customer-Owned Coin-Operated Telephone provider to serve its comments on all of the parties.

Consequently, subsequent to the filing deadline of May 20, 1993, the Commission will establish a service list of parties participating in this investigation and will then order an exchange of comments among those parties.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Any party which files comments by May 20, 1993 shall only serve the Commission.
2. Thereafter, any additional comments filed shall be served on the Commission and the service list established by the Commission.
