O R D E R

Pursuant to a previous Order of this Commission, a hearing in this matter shall commence on October 27, 1993. The Commission finds that, to ensure an orderly and productive hearing process, a procedural framework for this hearing should be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A hearing in this matter shall convene on October 27, 1993, at 10:00 a.m. Aside from the opening session of this hearing, all morning sessions shall begin at 9:00 a.m. and adjourn at 12:30 p.m. Afternoon sessions shall begin at 1:30 p.m. and continue to 6:00 p.m. Evening sessions shall begin at 7:00 p.m.

2. Opening statements at the scheduled hearing shall be presented in the following order: Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers ("KIUC"), Attorney General ("AG"), Williamette Industries ("Williamette"), and Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers"). Opening statements shall not exceed 15 minutes in length.

3. Testimony shall be presented in the following order: Overland Consulting, Inc., Big Rivers, KIUC, and AG.

4. Except as otherwise noted, cross-examination of witnesses shall be conducted in the following order: Big Rivers, KIUC, AG, Williamette, Overland, and Commission Staff.

5. Witnesses who have filed written direct and rebuttal testimony shall present that testimony at the same sitting. Opposing parties may cross examine such witnesses on both direct and rebuttal testimonies.

11. Any party may within 20 days of the filing of the hearing transcript with the Commission submit an initial written brief. Reply briefs shall be submitted no later than 15 days after the filing of initial briefs. No reply brief shall exceed 10 pages in length.
