ORDER

On May 12, 1993, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 92-331 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On April 23, 1993, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas was increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective April 1, 1993, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Western Lewis's notice of April 23, 1993 set out certain revisions in rates which Western Lewis proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase in price from its supplier, Transmission.

- Transmission applied with the Federal Energy Regulatory
 Commission for increased rates with an effective date of April 1,
 1993.
- 3. Western Lewis's rates were adjusted in Case No. 9642-NNN¹ based on Transmission's tariff effective May 1, 1993, which supersedes the tariff used in the instant filing. The rates proposed by Western Lewis should, therefore, be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Western Lewis's proposed rates be and they hereby are denied.
