ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that David Stawicki shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission by no later than June 10, 1993, with a copy to all parties of record. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. If the information cannot be provided by the stated date, Mr. Stawicki should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and a date by which the information will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

- 1. Refer to your testimony page 1, Question 4. Explain the basis for your conclusion that Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") has not sufficiently addressed alternatives to the pipeline.
- 2. Provide the evidence that you reference at page 7, Question 14, that indicates that demand management is the least cost source of water.
- 3. Address the argument that inverted rate structures unduly penalize large customers who have very favorable annual consumption patterns.

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- 4. State what measures would need to be taken to mitigate the potential impact on utility costs and revenues because of more aggressive consumer conservation.
- 5. State all the elements you believe should be present in an integrated resources management plan.
