O R D E R

On July 7, 1993, the Attorney General's office, Rate and Utility Intervention Division, ("AG") filed a motion requesting the Commission to establish a docket to investigate Kentucky-American Water Company's ("Kentucky-American") plan to construct a pipeline from Louisville to Lexington to carry treated water to be purchased from the Louisville Water Company. The AG states that the investigation should explore all available alternatives to the planned pipeline and suggests that an integrated resource plan be developed for Kentucky-American.

Based on the motion and being advised, the Commission hereby finds that the motion touches upon substantive issues pending in this case and, as a consequence, all parties should have an opportunity to respond to the motion, with a ruling to be issued at the time the merits of the pending rate case are adjudicated.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that any responses to the AG's motion shall be filed with the briefs that are due by July 30, 1993.
