<u>O R D E R</u>

On February 3, 1993, West Coast Telecommunications, Inc. ("West Coast Telecommunications") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

West Coast Telecommunications is a California corporation proposing to resell the services of telecommunications providers certified in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. West Coast Telecommunications is not seeking authority to provide any operator-assisted telecommunications services.

West Coast Telecommunications employs no transmission or reception telecommunications equipment or facilities in the performance of its services, and all operating facilities, equipment, and networking will be provided by the underlying carrier. West Coast Telecommunications will not construct any new facilities in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The information provided by West Coast Telecommunications demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications service. The proposed rates should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged. The Commission has also reviewed West Coast Telecommunications' proposed tariff filed February 3, 1993 and the revisions filed June 3, 1993 and July 15, 1993 and finds that a further revision must be made to the following provision:

1. Refer to Original Page 10, Item 8 of your July 15 filing. Substitute language stating that West Coast Telecommunications will fully comply with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 7, and furthermore, clearly explain West Coast Telecommunications' customer deposit policy.

The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by West Coast Telecommunications, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. West Coast Telecommunications be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.

2. West Coast Telecommunications shall comply with the provisions of the Orders in Administrative Case No. 323.¹

3. West Coast Telecommunications' authority to provide service in this Commonwealth is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and West Coast Telecommunications' application.

4. and charges proposed by West The rates Coast Telecommunications are hereby approved, as filed on February 3, 1993 and revised June 3, 1993 and July 15, 1993.

Within 30 days from the date of this Order, West Coast 5. Telecommunications shall file its February 3, 1993, as revised June 3, 1993 and July 15, 1993, tariff sheets, with the modifications set out above, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011 to conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
