ORDER

On February 11, 1993, Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance ("Working Assets") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Working Assets is a California corporation proposing to resell the services of US Sprint Communications Company. Working Assets is not seeking authority to provide any operator-assisted telecommunications services.

Working Assets employs no transmission or reception telecommunications equipment or facilities in the performance of its services, and all operating facilities, equipment, and networking will be provided by the underlying carrier. Working Assets will not construct any new facilities in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The information provided by Working Assets demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications service. The proposed rates should be approved as fair, just, and reasonable with the exception that operator services per minute rates must not exceed those charged by AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc.("AT&T")¹. This change should occur on Original Sheet No. 14 of Working Assets' April 20, 1993 tariff.

The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by Working Assets, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. Working Assets be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate, long-distance resold telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. Working Assets shall comply with the provisions of the Orders in Administrative Case No. 323.2
- 3. Working Assets' authority to provide service in this Commonwealth is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Working Assets' application.
- 4. The proposed rates and charges filed by Working Assets on April 20, 1993 be and they hereby are approved for service rendered

on and after the date of this Order except that Tariff Sheet No. 14 shall be modified so that the rates for operator services per minute shall not exceed those charged by AT&T.

5. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Working Assets shall file its approved tariff sheets in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011.
