## ORDER

On September 8, 1993, the Commission received a motion to withdraw as counsel from Anne Howard Shelbourne. Ms. Shelbourne is the attorney of record for the Intervenors in this case. The Commission has also been advised that on September 3, 1993, the office of the Breckenridge County Board of Health issued a notice to abate a nuisance to George Lucas, owner of Addison Water and Sewage Treatment Facilities, to stop the discharge of sewage from his plant into the Ohio River within 20 days or the Board of Health will order the utility shut down.

After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to grant Ms. Shelbourne's motion. We further find that the hearing scheduled for September 14, 1993 should be postponed until it is determined whether Mr. Lucas will abate the nuisance or whether the Board of Health will order him to cease his utility operation.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The motion to withdraw as counsel for the Intervenors by Anne Howard Shelbourne is granted.
- 2. The hearing scheduled for September 14, 1993 is hereby cancelled and will be rescheduled at a later date.
