ORDER

On March 26, 1993, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") filed its application requesting approval of several text changes in both its gas and electric service regulations. There are no intervenors in this case and ULH&P did not request a hearing.

After consideration of the tariffs, ULH&P's application, matters of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds the tariffs should be approved subject to the following exception. ULH&P's Gas Tariff Sheet No. 25.2, Section VI Billing and Payment and its corresponding Third Revised Sheet No. 25 for electric service both provide that meters are read at monthly intervals ". . . but may be read more or less frequently at Company's option." 807 KAR 5:006, Section 6(5) provides that meters shall be read at least quarterly if customer provided meter information is not used. As ULH&P reads customer meters and does not rely on customer supplied information, the phrase "but no less than quarterly" should be added to this provision for both the gas and electric regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. ULH&P's revised tariffs for gas and electric regulations be and they hereby are approved effective with the date of this Order subject to the exception noted above.
- 2. ULH&P shall refile the approved tariffs within 30 days of the date of this Order with the modification noted herein.
