O R D E R

On May 25, 1993, Boone County Water and Sewer District ("Boone District") applied for an adjustment of rates for certain sanitary sewer facilities which would increase annual operating revenues by \$216,530.

Pat Stinson, residents of Willow Bend Subdivision, Mineola Industrial Association, Inc. and Pepsi-Cola General Bottlers, Inc. intervened in this proceeding. None of the intervenors filed testimony or appeared at the scheduled hearing.

Commission Staff conducted a field review of Boone District's test-period financial records. Based upon this review, Commission Staff issued a Staff Report on September 20, 1993, recommending that Boone District be allowed to increase its annual operating revenues for sewer service by the requested amount of \$216,530. This report was filed in the record of this proceeding and considered as testimony.

On October 25, 1993, a hearing was held on Boone District's application. Boone District and Commission Staff offered their written testimony and moved that the case stand submitted for decision. Boone District further stipulated that Commission

Staff's recommendations were reasonable and should be accepted by the Commission.

The Commission, after consideration of the evidence of record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The recommendations and findings contained in the Staff Report are supported by the evidence of record, are reasonable, and are hereby adopted as the findings of the Commission in this proceeding and are incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

2. The rates proposed by Boone District should be granted.

3. The rates set forth in Appendix A, are the fair, just, and reasonable rates for Boone District, will produce gross annual revenues of \$1,068,216 for sewer service, and will allow Boone District sufficient revenues to meet its operating expenses.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Boone District and set forth in Appendix A are approved for service rendered by Boone District on and after the date of this Order.


2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Boone District shall file with the Commission its revised tariff setting out the rates approved herein.
