## ORDER

On May 7, 1993, Premier Billing Services, Inc. ("Premier") filed an application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Commission ordered Premier to file additional information on July 16, 1993. Premier filed its response on August 4, 1993.

Premier is an Illinois corporation with its principal offices in the state of Illinois and intends to resell tariffed services of facilities-based carriers certified by this Commission. Premier does not own or operate any telecommunications transmission facilities within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All telecommunications transmission services will be provided by an underlying carrier certified by this Commission.

The application provided by Premier demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability. The Commission finds that Premier should be authorized to resell intrastate longdistance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Commission further finds that the rates proposed by Premier should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged. The Commission has also reviewed Premier's proposed May 7, 1993 tariff and the revised tariff sheets filed August 4, 1993. The Commission finds that further revisions must be made to the following provisions:

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 Refer to Exhibit C of your August 4, 1993 proposed tariff sheets. Insert the word "give" after the word "shall" in Heading 2.11.1.

2. Refer to Exhibit F of your August 4, 1993 proposed tariff sheets. The last sentence in Heading 3.2.4 is an unnecessary addendum and should be removed.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Premier be and it hereby is granted authority to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.

2. Premier's authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Premier's application.

3. IntraLATA services shall be provided in accordance with the restrictions and conditions of service contained in Administrative Case No. 323.<sup>1</sup>

4. The rates proposed by Premier on May 7, 1993, and revised on August 4, 1993, are hereby approved subject to the revisions required by this Order.

5. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Premier shall file its May 7, 1993 tariff sheets, as revised on August 4, 1993 and incorporating the changes noted above, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 and to conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
