ORDER

On May 12, 1993, the Commission received an application from WATS International Corporation ("WATS International") requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a reseller of interLATA telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. In its filing, WATS International requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 2, which requires the filing of two cover letters and four complete copies of a tariff containing schedules of all rates.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to adequately review WATS International's filing. Therefore, its request for a deviation from the above-cited regulation is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that WATS International's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 2, is hereby granted.
