ORDER

On September 9, 1993, the Commission entered an Order in this proceeding directing Beaver-Elkhorn Water District ("Beaver-Elkhorn") to file the engineering plans and specifications related to its proposed project. The Commission further ordered that if the information was not filed by September 20, 1993 this case would be dismissed without prejudice without further order of the Commission. On September 20, 1993, Beaver-Elkhorn filed a motion to amend the Commission's Order and extend time to October 8, 1993.

After consideration of the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be denied. When and if the engineering plans and specifications are available for the Commission's review, Beaver-Elkhorn may request this case be reopened.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
