O R D E R

On August 6, 1993, the Commission received a letter from a customer of Southern Madison Water District ("Southern Madison") claiming that the charges proposed in Southern Madison's tariff are already being charged. A copy of the letter is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Appendix A. Attached to the letter was a cancelled check made payable to Southern Madison on July 6, 1993, for \$525. The customer was apparently charged a \$475 meter installation charge and a \$50 deposit charge. These charges are not the tariffed rates currently on file with the Commission. A copy of the check is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Appendix B.

Accordingly, the Commission finds that additional information is necessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 10 days from the date of this Order, Southern Madison shall file the following:

a. A list of all bills sent out during the previous 6 months for meter installation and connection fee. Include the customer's name, address, date collected, and amount charged.

c. A list of any other nonrecurring charge which Southern Madison has collected over the previous 6 months; include the customer's name, address, service provided, date service was provided, and amount charged.

The money that is being asked for is already being charged to the customers. Enclosed Concurred Check copy. When Wayne Runspord term expired, as Commissioner.

The members of the district got a petition signed 800 names and gave it to County Judge Bill Robbins asking him to reappoint Wayne Runspord as Commissioner but he refused and appointed Paul Reynolds instead. Now Leonard E. term expired. Judge Robbins was asked again not to appoint Larry Todd but according to what he told some of the customers, Larry Todd had done him

Some Political favors. We think all three of the Commissioners are democrats the last two by appointments were made for Political favors. Please refer to the Minutes of the Meetings where Harry Todd was fired from the Water District for insubordination.

When Harry Todd was Superintendent. He Had Absolutely no Road Repairing System. He MisHandled Public funds. He Had Public Property Destroyed Good Water Meters, and other Water district property. He Had a truck hooked up on the Water District that was Not using a meter.

Paul Reynolds, Commissioner is an insurance Agent. The Southern Madison Water District Has their insurance with him which is a Conflict of interest.

Two past Commissioners say this proposed raise is unjustified.

65 to 70 Percent of the People on Southern Madison Water District is living on an income below the Poverty level.
