O R D E R

The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") has moved for acceptance of its answer to the complaint. Having reviewed the motion and attached Answer and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted and a formal hearing in this matter should be held.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. ULH&P's motion to accept its answer is granted. ULH&P's Answer is accepted for filing.

2. A formal hearing in this matter shall be held on October 20, 1993, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, and continuing until completed.

3. Each party may, on or before September 8, 1993, serve upon any other party a request for production of documents and written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 14 days of service.

4. Each party may, on or before September 22, 1993, serve upon any other party a written request for admission, for purposes of this proceeding only, of the truth of any matter relevant to this proceeding set forth in the request that relates to statements or opinions of fact or of the application of law to fact. The matter is admitted unless, within 14 days after service of the request, the party to whom the request is directed serves upon the party requesting the admission a written answer or objection. The form of the request for admission and the answer or objection thereto shall otherwise be governed by Kentucky Civil Rule 36.

5. Each party may, on or before September 29, 1993, take the testimony of any person by deposition upon oral examination pursuant to notice or by agreement.

6. Each party shall, on or before October 13, 1993, serve upon the other parties a written summary of the testimony of the witnesses which it expects to call at the formal hearing and copies of all exhibits to be introduced at that hearing. All exhibits shall be appropriately marked.

7. Copies of all documents served upon any party shall be served on all other parties and filed with the Commission.
