### ORDER

On July 27, 1993, Pendleton County Kentucky Water District ("Pendleton County") filed its application with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Pendleton County purchases water from two suppliers, the city of Falmouth ("Falmouth") and Campbell County Water District ("Campbell County").
- 2. Campbell County increased its rate for water sold from \$1.54 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.5832 per 1,000 gallons effective June 15, 1993. The other supplier, Falmouth, will not increase its rate at this time. Pendleton County proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective August 15, 1993.
- 3. During the 12 months ending May 31, 1993, Pendleton County purchased 85,326,312 gallons of water and sold 80,906,268 gallons. These figures are representative of both suppliers.

Pendleton County purchased 55,605,312 gallons of water from Campbell County.

- 4. The increase in Pendleton County's purchased water cost is \$2,402.15, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$.03 per 1,000 gallons as shown in Appendix B. Based on an average of 5,000 gallons, the average bill of Pendleton County's customers would increase \$0.15 from 25.75 to 25.90, or 0.6 percent.
- 5. The purchased water adjustment of \$.03 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 6. Pendleton County's proposed tariff is incorrect and should be denied.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Pendleton County's proposed tariffs are denied.
- 2. The purchased water adjustment of \$.03 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are hereby approved for services rendered on and after August 15, 1993.
- 3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Pendleton County shall file revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.
- 4. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Pendleton County shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.
