ORDER

On October 20, 1993, Rowan Water, Inc. ("Rowan Water") filed an application with the Commission for authority to increase its tap on fee for $5/8 \times 3/4$ inch meters from \$255 to \$400, and to charge actual cost of installation plus 15 percent overhead for all other size meters.

Rowan Water has provided adequate evidence of the individual expenses incurred to provide the services associated with the proposed charges. After reviewing the evidence and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.
- 2. The charges set forth in Appendix A to this Order, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges in Appendix A to this Order are approved for services rendered on and after the date of this Order.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Rowan Water shall file its revised tariff sheets setting forth the charges approved herein.
