ORDER

On October 21, 1993, South 641 Water and Sewer District ("South 641") applied to the Commission to increase its water and sewer connection fees. On November 3, 1993, the Commission issued a letter listing filing deficiencies which included the requirement to file a copy of the public notice. On November 18, South 641 cured its filing deficiencies except for the public notice requirement and requested a deviation from the requirement, citing the expense of the notice as being prohibitive.

The Commission finds that public notification of the rate increase is necessary and outweighs the reason given by South 641 for requesting the deviation; therefore, the request should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. South 641's request for deviation be and it hereby is denied.
- 2. South 641 shall, within 30 days of the date of this Order, file a copy of the public notice with the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, or withdraw its application.
