ORDER

On November 12, 1993, American Telecommunications Enterprise, Inc. ("American Enterprise") filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate resold telecommunications services in accordance with its proposed tariff. The proposed tariff contains rates which become effective on and after December 20, 1993.

After reviewing the proposed tariff, the Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff is hereby suspended for 5 months from December 20, 1993 up to and including May 19, 1994.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
