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ORDER

On December 22, 1993, in Case No. 92-558, the Commission approved, on an experimental basis, a mechanism for the monthly adjustment of rates for Western Kentucky Gas Company ("Western") in accordance with the gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause set forth in the Order.

On June 1, 1994, Western filed its monthly GCA to be effective from July 1, 1994 to August 1, 1994.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Western's notice proposed revised rates designed to pass on to its firm sales customers an expected wholesale decrease in gas costs in the amount of 16.74 cents per Mcf. Western's proposed expected gas cost ("EGC") for firm sales customers is \$3.0658 per Mcf.

Western also proposed to pass on to its interruptible customers a wholesale decrease in gas costs. Western's proposed EGC for interruptible sales customers is \$2.4932 per Mcf.

2. Western had no supplier refunds to report; however, its notice proposed a current refund adjustment to collect net over-refund amounts from its customers. Total refund factors of 1.5 cents per Mcf for firm sales customers and .90 cent per Mcf for interruptible customers reflect this current adjustment as well as an adjustment from a previous month.

Western's notice set out no current refund adjustments for firm or interruptible transportation customers. Total refund adjustments of .92 cent and .32 cent per Mcf, respectively, are from a previous month.

- 3. Western's notice set out the 6-month correction factor of (2.16) cents per Mcf which will remain in effect until October 1, 1994.
- 4. These adjustments produce gas cost adjustments of (\$.4052) per Mcf for firm sales customers and (\$.7145) per Mcf for interruptible sales customers.
- 5. The rate adjustments in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective for final meter readings on and after July 1, 1994.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective for final meter readings on and after July 1, 1994.
- 2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Western shall file with the Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized in this Order.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 92-558-F DATED July 8, 1994.

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Western Kentucky Gas Company. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

RATES:

Applicable to: General Sales Service Rate G-1

Gas Cost Adjustment

To each bill rendered under the above-named rate schedules there shall be added an amount equal to: (\$.4052) per Mcf of gas used during the billing period.

Applicable to: Interruptible Sales Service Rate G-2

Gas Cost Adjustment

To each bill rendered under the above-named rate schedules there shall be added an amount equal to: (\$.7145) per Mcf of gas used during the billing period.
