O R D E R

On May 4, 1994, Coin Phone Management Company ("Coin Phone") filed a motion to hold this matter in abeyance pending the resolution of certain similar issues by the Federal Communications Commission. The motion also indicated that the parties have no objection to the motion.

After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Coin Phone's motion is granted in its entirety.
2. The hearing scheduled for May 23, 1994 is cancelled.
3. Ordering paragraph 2 of the Commission's April 18, 1994 Order is suspended.
4. Unless Coin Phone files a petition for reestablishing a procedural schedule on or before August 1, 1994, this case will be dismissed without further Order of the Commission.
