ORDER

On August 30, 1993, Executone Information Systems, Inc. ("Executone") filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate resold telecommunications services. In response to the Commission's October 21, 1993 Order requesting additional information, Executone filed its proposed tariff containing rates which become effective on and after January 16, 1994.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff is hereby suspended for 5 months from January 16, 1994 up to and including June 15, 1994.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
