- 1. Explain how Bullock Pen or its customers will benefit from the proposed refund policy versus its current policy.
- 2. Explain why Bullock Pen is only proposing to charge \$585 for its 1-inch connection fee rather than the \$640 supported by the cost justification filed with the response to the Commission's Order dated May 25, 1994.
- 3. Bullock Pen's proposed tariff states that the owner of the mobile home park shall be required to pay a Tap-In or connection fee to the District. Bullock Pen's response to the

Commission's May 25, 1994 Order states that the connection fee is paid by the homeowner or mobile home owner. Explain which answer is correct.
