<u>O R D E R</u>

On May 5, 1994, the Commission issued an Order directing Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia Gas") to appear at a hearing scheduled for June 17, 1994 and be prepared to show cause why Columbia Gas should not be penalized pursuant to KRS 278.990 for its alleged violation of KRS.020(1).

An informal conference was held at the Commission on June 1, 1994 to discuss matters at issue in this proceeding. As a result of that conference, Commission Staff and Columbia Gas are currently attempting to negotiate a settlement in this matter. The Commission therefore finds that the hearing scheduled for June 17, 1994 should be cancelled pending the outcome of these discussions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for June 17, 1994 is cancelled, to be rescheduled at a later date if necessary.
