## ORDER

On May 19, 1994, Universal Network Services of Kentucky, Inc. ("Universal Network") filed an application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Universal Network was ordered to file additional information on July 12, 1994. Universal Network filed its response on August 11, 1994.

Universal Network is a Nevada corporation with its principal offices in the state of California and intends to resell tariffed services of facilities-based carriers certified by this Commission. Universal Network does not request authority to provide operatorassisted telecommunications services.

Universal Network does not own or operate, nor does it intend to construct, any telecommunications transmission facilities within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All intrastate telecommunications transmission services will be provided by an underlying carrier certified by this Commission.

Universal Network filed its proposed tariff on May 19, 1994. In response to the Commission's request for additional information, Universal Network filed revised tariff sheets on August 11, 1994.

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The application provided by Universal Network demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide utility service. The Commission finds that Universal Network should be authorized to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Commission further finds that the rates proposed by Universal Network on May 19, 1994, as revised on August 11, 1994, should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. Universal Network be and it hereby is granted authority to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. Universal Network's authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Universal Network's application.
- 3. IntraLATA services shall be provided in accordance with the restrictions and conditions of service contained in Administrative Case No. 323.1

Administrative Case No. 323, An Inquiry Into IntraLATA Toll Competition, An Appropriate Compensation Scheme for Completion of IntraLATA Calls by Interexchange Carriers, and WATS Jurisdictionality, Phase I, Order Dated May 6, 1991.

- 4. The rates proposed by Universal Network on May 19, 1994, as revised on August 11, 1994, are hereby approved.
- 5. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Universal Network shall file, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, its May 19, 1994 tariff sheets, as revised on August 11, 1994, which conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
