O R D E R

The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") has applied for a deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:022, Section 8(2)(a),¹ to provide non-metered gas service to future customers who request gas for gas street lighting requirements.

ULH&P represents that gas street lighting units require gas at a set pressure, and precise amounts of usage can be computed.

ULH&P will provide the construction schedule to the Commission for any new gas street lighting units no later than 7 days prior to the installation of those units. ULH&P will submit the as-built drawings of the gas street lighting units, including the regulation facilities from the gas main to burner head, within 90 days of completion of construction. ULH&P will provide a valve and regulator, but the customer is responsible for installation, operation, and maintenance of the lighting fixture. ULH&P will inspect the construction as it does on any gas service and house

¹ All gas sold by a utility and all gas consumed by a utility in the State of Kentucky shall be metered through approved type meters except in cases of emergency or when otherwise authorized by the commission.

pipng. The customer will be billed according to Rate GS, General Service in its tariff as approved by the Commission.

In a previous case, ULH&P was granted a deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:022, Section 8, to provide non-metered gas service for street lighting to the Ashley Greene Subdivision in Edgewood, Kentucky.²

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to permit ULH&P to deviate from the provisions of Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:022, Section 8.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. ULH&P is granted a deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:022, Section 8, to provide non-metered gas service for street lighting to future customers under the conditions specified in its application.


2. ULH&P shall file with the Commission its revised tariffs for gas street lighting within 30 days of the date of this Order.


