O R D E R

On September 9, 1994, World Wide Communications, Inc. ("World Wide") filed an application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. On November 10, 1994, World Wide filed its response to the Commission's November 3, 1994 Order requesting additional information.

World Wide is a Nevada corporation with its principal offices in the state of Nevada and intends to resell tariffed services of facilities-based carriers certified by this Commission. World Wide has not requested authority to provide operator-assisted telecommunications services.

World Wide does not own or operate, nor does it intend to construct, any telecommunications transmission facilities within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All intrastate telecommunications transmission services will be provided by an underlying carrier certified by this Commission.

World Wide filed its proposed tariff on September 9, 1994. In response to the Commission's request for additional information, World Wide filed revised tariff sheets on November 10, 1994.

The application provided by World Wide demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide utility service. The Commission finds that World Wide should be authorized to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Commission further finds that the rates proposed by World Wide, as revised on November 10, 1994, should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. World Wide be and it hereby is granted authority to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.

2. World Wide's authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and World Wide's application.

3. IntraLATA services shall be provided in accordance with the restrictions and conditions of service contained in Administrative Case No. 323.¹


4. The rates proposed by World Wide on September 9, 1994, as revised on November 10, 1994, are hereby approved.

5. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, World Wide shall file, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, its September 9, 1994 tariff sheets, as revised on November 10, 1994, without modifications and which conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
