<u>O R D E R</u>

On November 9, 1994, Sigma Gas Corporation ("Sigma") applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct pipeline facilities and approval of related financing. In its filing, Sigma requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(d).

807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(d), requires the submission of three maps to suitable scale showing the location or route of the proposed new construction or extension, as well as the location to scale of any like facilities owned by others located anywhere within the map area with adequate identification as to the ownership of such other facilities. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the submission of two maps of suitable scale is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Sigma's filing. Therefore, its request for a deviation from the above-cited regulation should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Sigma's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(d), is hereby granted.
