<u>ORDER</u>

Parties may file data requests of each other by September
18, 1995, with responses due no later than December 15, 1995.

2. Parties may file additional comments, which also shall be considered prefiled testimony, and shall be due no later than February 1, 1996.

3. Responses to the prefiled testimony shall be due no later than February 22, 1996.
