ORDER

On August 3, 1995, Contel Cellular of Kentucky, Inc. ("Contel Cellular") filed a motion requesting that the Commission dismiss its application for authority to construct a cellular telecommunications facility at 8290 Richmond Road, Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky. In support of its motion, Contel Cellular states that it has entered into an Extension Agreement with Horizon Cellular Telephone Company of Central Kentucky, L.P. ("Horizon") which will allow Contel Cellular to extend its coverage into Horizon's certified territory. This agreement will allow Contel Cellular to locate its cellular facility on an existing water tower in Madison County, thus negating the need for this application.

Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause exists to dismiss the application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Contel Cellular's motion to dismiss is granted and this case is dismissed.
