ORDER

On November 29, 1994, Boone County Water and Sewer District ("Boone County") filed tariff revisions to require lateral connections of eight inches or greater and to implement a new transmission line extension reimbursement program. On December 28, 1994, the Commission suspended the tariff filing for five months beginning January 1, 1995 for further review and consideration of the proposed change in extension policy.

On March 8, 1995, the Commission issued a data request in this case. The utility's response was received March 23, 1995. As Boone County did not provide persuasive documentation to justify the tariff revisions, the Commission denied the proposed tariff on May 31, 1995.

On June 21, 1995, Boone County filed a petition pursuant to KRS 278.400 requesting rehearing and additional time to submit supplementary documentation to permit the Public Service Commission to undertake a more thorough review of Boone County's request. Having found that good cause exists, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Case No. 94-526 should be re-opened in order to allow Boone County the opportunity to submit additional documentation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Case No. 94-526 shall be reopened effective June 21, 1995. Boone County shall have 20 days
from the date of this Order in which to submit supplementary
documentation in support of its application. If no supplementary
documentation is submitted within 20 days of the date of this
Order, this case shall be dismissed without further Order of the
Commission.
