IT IS ORDERED that Commonwealth Energy Services ("CES") shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission no later than May 24, 1995, with a copy to all parties of record. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided.

- 1. Is CES aware of any industrial gas transportation customer who has voluntarily chosen to install telemetering equipment?
- 2. How many customers of CES transport gas on Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E's") system? Of these, how many object to the installation of telemetry equipment? How many object to the other tariff modifications?
- 3. Does the imbalance tolerance increase (from 5 percent to 10 percent) negotiated between LG&E and KIUC provide an acceptable alternative to the enforcement of the existing 5 percent tolerance level? Why?

4. Who manages "line-pack?"
