O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Commonwealth Energy Services ("CES") shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission no later than May 24, 1995, with a copy to all parties of record. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided.

1. Is CES aware of any industrial gas transportation customer who has voluntarily chosen to install telemetering equipment?


2. How many customers of CES transport gas on Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E's") system? Of these, how many object to the installation of telemetry equipment? How many object to the other tariff modifications?

3. Does the imbalance tolerance increase (from 5 percent to 10 percent) negotiated between LG&E and KIUC provide an acceptable alternative to the enforcement of the existing 5 percent tolerance level? Why?

4. Who manages "line-pack?"
