On March 31, 1995, Dr. George Zarocostas filed a Complaint alleging that GTE South Incorporated ("GTE South") had billed him, for a period of years, for services he did not receive. On May 4, 1995, GTE South filed its Answer to the Complaint, and on June 14, 1995, the parties met with Commission Staff in informal conference. Subsequently, on July 17, 1995, Dr. Zarocostas filed with the Commission a letter stating that he and GTE had settled their dispute and that no further action in this case is required. The Commission will treat Dr. Zarocostas's letter as a motion to dismiss.
