ORDER

On September 11, 1995, Lake Columbia Utilities, Inc. applied to the Commission for authority to acquire Lake Columbia Estates Sewer System from its owner Charlotte LaFaive. KRS 278.020(5) provides that transfer applications be ruled upon by the Commission within a 60-day period unless an extension is mutually agreed upon. Since the Commission and Lake Columbia Utilities, Inc. have mutually agreed to an extension, the Commission finds good cause to continue the transfer application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.020(5).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Lake Columbia Utilities. Inc.'s application for authority to acquire the Lake Columbia Estates Sewer System is continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.020(5).
