ORDER

On May 1, 1995 Lilly B. Scott filed a complaint with the Commission alleging she had been denied gas service by Ashland Oil and Gas Co. Ms. Scott further alleges that her complaint is the same as the complaint alleged in Case No. 94-317. However, the Defendant named in the instant case, Ashland Oil and Gas Co., is one over which the Commission has no jurisdiction and the Defendant named in Case No. 94-317 is Ashland Exploration, Inc. which is a jurisdictional utility.

Based upon the foregoing, the Complainant, Lilly B. Scott, should have 20 days from the date of this Order to amend her complaint to name a defendant over which this Commission has jurisdiction or her complaint will be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Complainant shall amend her complaint within 20 days or her complaint shall be dismissed without further Order of this Commission.
