ORDER

On July 19, 1995, Beaver-Elkhorn Water District ("Beaver-Elkhorn") filed a motion for an extension of time to August 4, 1995 in which to respond to the Commission's June 28, 1995 Order.

KRS 278.300(2) requires applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidences of indebtedness to be ruled on within 60 days unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. Granting Beaver-Elkhorn's motion for an extension will only allow the Commission five working days to review the information and issue its Order. Therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).

After consideration of the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERs that:

1. Beaver-Elkhorn's motion for an extension of time to August 4, 1995 in which to respond to the Commission's June 28, 1995 Order is granted.

2. Beaver-Elkhorn's application for authority to incur additional indebtedness is continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
