ORDER

On May 18, 1995, Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Taylor County RECC") applied to the Commission for authority to incur additional indebtedness to finance its 1995-1997 construction work plan. Commission approval of the construction is pending in Case No. 95-125.

KRS 278.300(2) requires applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidences of indebtedness to be ruled on within 60 days unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. Additional information is needed in the record of Case No. 95-125 and it will be necessary to extend the time for ruling on the financing application beyond the 60-day limit in order to obtain and review the construction-related information. Therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue

the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
