O R D E R

To satisfy the complaint of Symsonia Fire District, Symsonia Water District has requested withdrawal of its fire hydrant charge. Effective November 1, 1995, this charge was withdrawn and authority for its assessment ceased.¹ Following Symsonia Water District's action, Symsonia Fire District moved for entry of default judgment.

Finding that Symsonia Water District's action has satisfied the complaint and renders Symsonia Fire District's motion moot, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:


1. Symsonia Fire District's Motion for Default Judgment is denied.


2. This case is closed and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
