On August 15, 1995, Amtel Communications, Inc. ("Amtel") filed a letter, which the Commission will treat as a motion, requesting to withdraw its August 4, 1995 application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Amtel states that it has no Kentucky customers and has removed Kentucky from its marketing plan. Based on the motion and being advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow the application to be withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Amtel's motion to withdraw its application is granted and this case is dismissed.
