ORDER

On July 28, 1995, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") filed tariff revisions to propose implementation of a capacity release revenue sharing mechanism and an off-system sales revenue sharing mechanism.

The Commission finds, pursuant to KRS 278.190, that further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the tariff filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff be and is hereby suspended for five months from September 1, 1995 up to and including January 31, 1996.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
