O R D E R

On September 7, 1995, Professional Communications Management Services, Inc. d/b/a PROCOM filed an application seeking to amend a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. PROCOM seeks to expand the authority granted in 1990 to include the provision of operator services on a resale basis.

The Commission finds that an application need not be filed by an authorized reseller wishing to provide operator services. The authorized reseller wishing to provide operator services in the Commonwealth should simply modify its tariff on file with the Commission in compliance with Administrative Case No. 330.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by PROCOM, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that this case is dismissed.
