## ORDIR

On November 27, 1995, the Commission received a letter from the complainant Patty L. Pugh, requesting that the hearing scheduled in this matter be held in Pikeville, Kentucky instead of the Commission's facilities in Frankfort. The Commission will treat the letter as a motion.

After consideration of the Complainant's request and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds the motion should be denied. Although the Complainant requests the hearing be moved to Pikeville to make it more convenient for both Complainants to attend, granting the motion would be a great inconvenience to the Commission. It would also set a precedent for other complainants which the Commission could not possibly follow for all cases before it.
