By letter filed November 21, 1995, Rowan Water, Inc. advised the Commission that as the project for which it sought a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was not slated to be bid until Spring of 1996, it would re-apply for a rate change at that time. The Commission considers this letter as a motion to dismiss this case. Having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds the motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Rowan Water, Inc.'s motion to dismiss is granted.
2. This case is dismissed without prejudice and is removed from the Commission's docket.
