## ORDER

This matter arising upon petition ofBellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), filed October 6, 1995, for confidential protection of the cost data filed in support of its proposed revisions of its tariff to restructure the service charges for obtaining exchange access lines, making changes on existing service, or adding service other than exchange access lines, on the grounds that disclosure of the information is likely to cause BellSouth competitive injury, and it appearing that the petition does not identify any competitors who could make use of the information, nor establish how competitors could use information to BellSouth's detriment, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that BellSouth shall file the following information with the Commission no later than 20 days from the date of this Order:

1. Identify by name and the type of service provided, each competitor of BellSouth to whom the information sought to be protected would be of substantial value.

2. Describe how each of the competitors could use the information to BellSouth's detriment.
