ORDER

On August 25, 1995, One Call Communications, Inc. ("One Call") filed a tariff with the Commission wherein it proposed to establish a public set use fee. The proposed fee of \$0.25 would be billed to and collected from end users by One Call for 0+ intraLATA company processed, completed billed messages which originate from customer owned, coin-operated telephones ("COCOT") and local exchange carrier ("LEC") pay telephones.

On August 17, 1995, Coin Phone Management Company filed a "'Set Use' Fee Petition" asking the Commission to authorize all independent pay telephone providers to receive a "set use" fee for all local, intraLATA, and interLATA long-distance 0-/0+ revenue producing calls made on Kentucky COCOTs. To allow all telecommunications providers an opportunity to participate in the proceeding, on October 2, 1995, the Commission established Administrative Case No. 356.1

Administrative Case No. 356, Inquiry Into the Feasibility of Set Use Fee For Telecommunications Service in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Commission finds that One Call's tariff filing to establish a set use fee should be suspended pending the outcome of Administrative Case No. 356. One Call may become a party to Administrative Case No. 356 by filing with the Commission by November 1, 1995, a statement that it wishes to participate in the proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that One Call's tariff filing to establish a set use fee be and it hereby is suspended pending the outcome of Administrative Case No. 356.
