O R D E R


On November 13, 1995, Interstate Gas Marketing, Inc. ("IGM") applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct pipeline facilities, approval of a special contract for transportation of natural gas, and authority to operate a natural gas transportation pipeline. In its filing, IGM requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f).

807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f), requires the submission of the estimated cost of operation after the proposed facilities are completed. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately IGM's filing. Therefore, its request for a deviation from the above-cited regulation should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that IGM's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f), is hereby granted.
