O R D E R

This matter arising upon the motion of AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T") for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that AT&T has a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented, and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion of AT&T to intervene is granted.
2. AT&T shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Should AT&T file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
4. AT&T shall adhere to the procedural schedule attached as Appendix B to the Commission's January 4, 1996 Order.
