

O R D E R

The Commission entered an Order in this case addressing all issues with the exception of Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc.'s ("Delta") request for confidential treatment of information provided in response to a Commission Order. On January 2, 1996, Delta withdrew its request for confidential treatment.

In its Order of September 7, 1995, the Commission ordered Delta to file an application for approval of the transfer of storage assets from Deltran, Inc., a Delta subsidiary, to Delta at least 60 days prior to the effective date of the transfer. Since this Order was entered, Delta and Deltran have entered into an operating lease agreement which eliminates the necessity of a transfer application under KRS 278.020. Ordering paragraph 6 of the Commission's September 7, 1995 Order should therefore be vacated and this case should be removed from the Commission's docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The information previously protected as confidential pending a ruling on Delta's motion for confidential protection shall be placed in the public record of this case.

2. Ordering paragraph 6 of the Commission's September 7, 1995 Order is vacated.

3. All issues having been disposed of by the Commission, this case is closed.
